## Old Business:

### **Treasurer's Report:**

- S G reported there are currently a checking account balance of \$3,174.81 and a savings account balance of \$536.11. There is a total of \$1,031.78 in outstanding funds requests. The total available balance is \$2,679.14.
- D motioned to approve this month's treasurer's minutes. B W seconded and the minutes were approved.

### **Membership:**

- Total members for SY 2006-2007 is 270.

### **Hospitality:**

- S S reported that the teacher's lunch was a success. The left over food was taken to the chapel and used at the children's Halloween party. \$68.25 was spent from PTSA funds. S has also signed up approximately 30 people who are willing to bring in a dish anytime PTSA has a function where food is needed.

### **Shirt Orders**

- T-shirt orders are still trickling in. S recommended using profits from the shirts that have already been sold to order more, especially in the smaller sizes. D motioned to approve \$399 worth of t-shirts be purchased to have on-hand and ready for sale. G seconded the motion. The motion passed.

## New Business:

- The PTSA is still searching for someone to take over the Hospitality position. How can we ever replace S S?
- The Book Fair will be held November 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are needed and G has provided a list of individuals who have previously stated that would like to help.
- A membership table will be set up during parent/teacher conferences. PTSA needs volunteers to work in shifts. G will promote membership in the school newsletters and Wednesday folders. A list of 'What PTSA Has Accomplished So Far' will be put together to raise the PR level, especially at the high school. Any info that PTSA would like to have in the middle/high school newsletter should be sent to Mr. Bean.

- The December general membership meeting will be on 12 December 2006 at 1900. The PTSA will have a brief general membership meeting before the Christmas performances start.
- The PTSA is considering having a member go to every classroom on Fridays to find the class with the most students who are wearing their school shirts. The class who wins would receive a treat, possibly popcorn or popsicles.

G motioned to adjourn the PTSA meeting. K seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 1610.
